Notes:

- All this year's trips and themes have come from feedback from staff, parents, and children. Thank you to all who gave us their feedback.
- If possible, all children should bring their free bus pass with them. If not the additional £2 will be charged.
- Children should bring the following every day: Packed lunch (**no hot food or fizzy drinks**) water bottle, walking shoes and waterproof jacket.
- Current P6/7 children with signed permission forms, can bring their phones to the service, but are not allowed them out on trips
- Children are not encouraged to bring their own toys, books, and pencil cases as we have plenty here. If they do, it is at their parents' own risk. Children will not be allowed to take toys on trips.
- 2 snacks are provided free every day, one at about 10am and the other at about 3pm. This may be later if we are on trips.
- Additional money for trips should be paid on the day in cash as we use this to pay for the attraction activity on the day.
- All trips and transport are subsidised by ROSC funds to keep costs to parents as low as possible.
- Children will not need any additional spending money unless mentioned.
- Trips may be changed due to circumstances beyond our control. If this is the case, we will try to provide a similar trip instead.
